| Overview                 | <p>Video:</p> <p>Must be submitted on a flashdrive<br/>           Format must be WMV; MOV or MP4<br/>           Must be between 5-10 minutes in length<br/>           All interviews must be recorded and all recordings must be submitted with the project</p> <p>Book:</p> <p>Must be submitted in paper form<br/>           Must have 1500-2500 words<br/>           Must include at least 5 primary sources referenced in the body of the text<br/>           All interviews must be recorded and all recordings must be submitted with the project</p> |
| Context/Content          | <p>Emphasis on one Bristol historical topic (See other information provided for more on topic suggestions)<br/>           Must be family appropriate<br/>           Must include at least one interview<br/>           All material must be credited at the end of the video/book; citations must be in proper MLA format</p>   |
| Rights                   | <p>All submissions become the property of The Bristol Historical Society<br/>           No music/pictures that are copyrighted can be used unless you have secure written permission from the artist.</p>   |
| Age/Grade/qualifications | <p>This scholarship competition is open to all students in grades 10-14 (sophomores in high school through sophomore in college)<br/>           Applications must fill out an application by January 3<sup>rd</sup><br/>           The applicant is encouraged to take advantage of the resources available at the Bristol Historical Society<br/>           The final project is due by MARCH 30, 2015</p>   |
